A bay with provision for public telephones; Access should be provided for persons with disabilities. The Public Telephone Bay should be located where justified, such as, Main Entry and Emergency Department. Security considerations:- Fixed to wall to prevent theft/tampering. Design considerations:- A 2m2 bay will accommodate one (1) public telephone and a taxi phone. Add 1m2 per additional telephone.- A bay is shown, however, wall mounted in a corridor may be an alternate approach.
